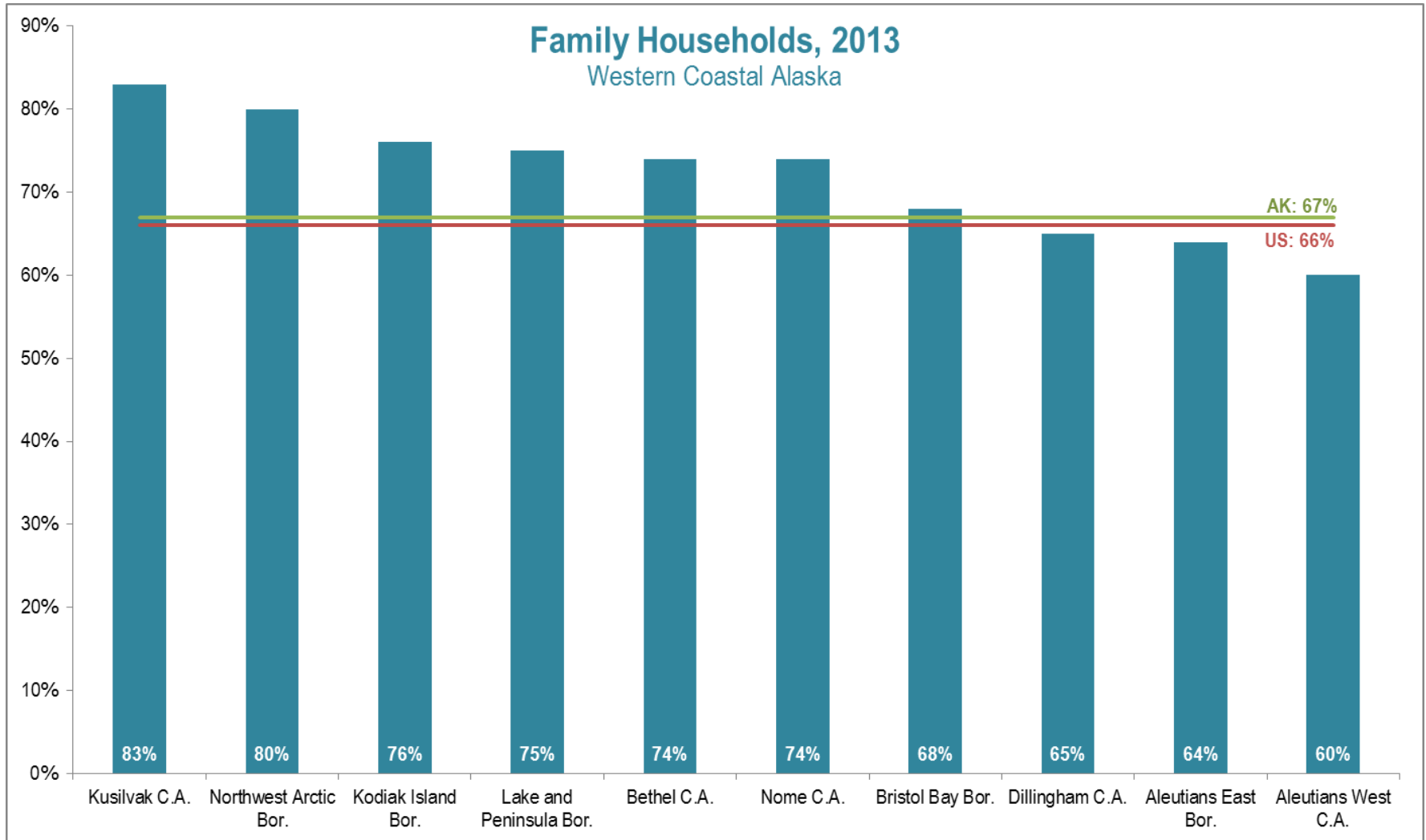

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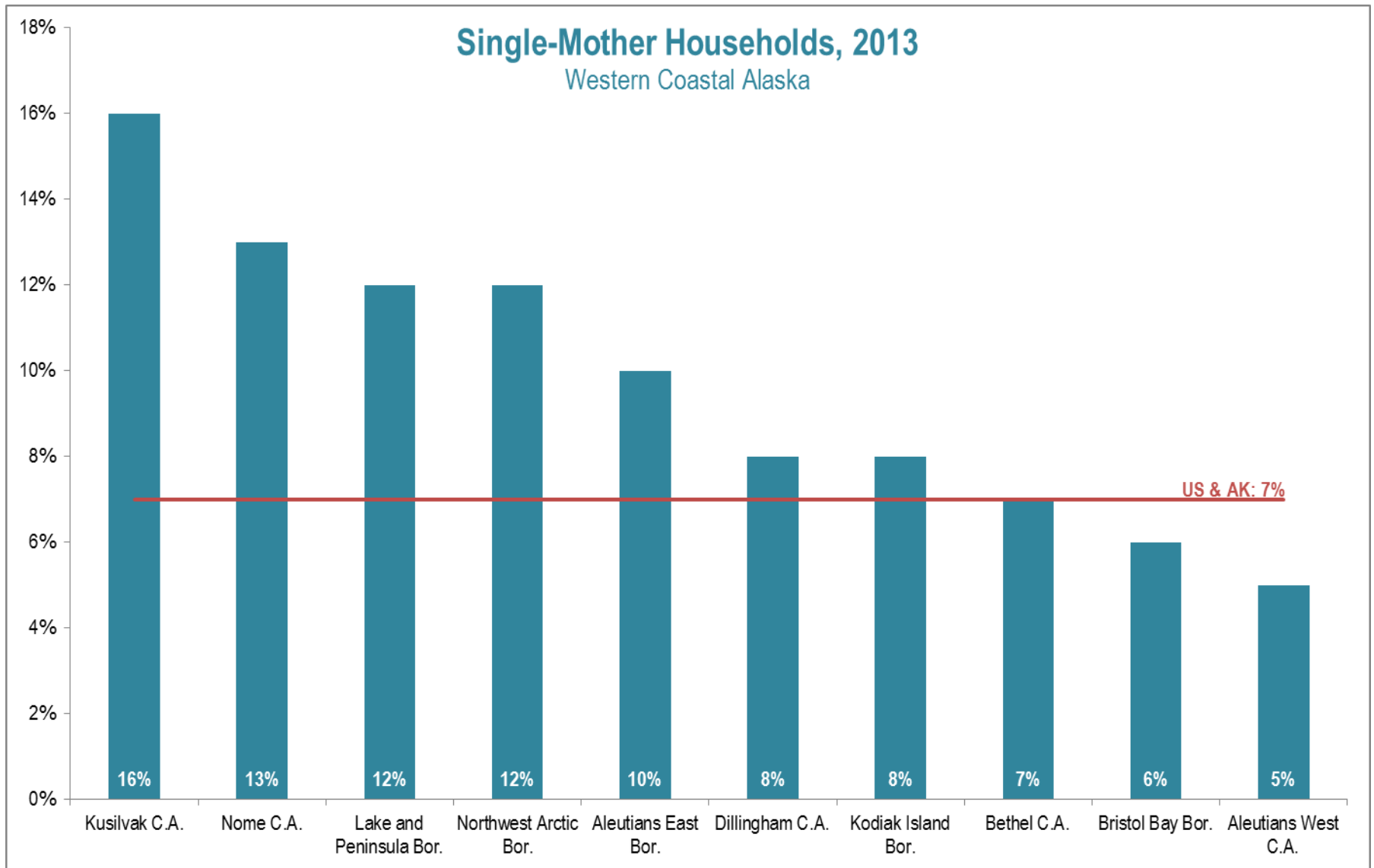

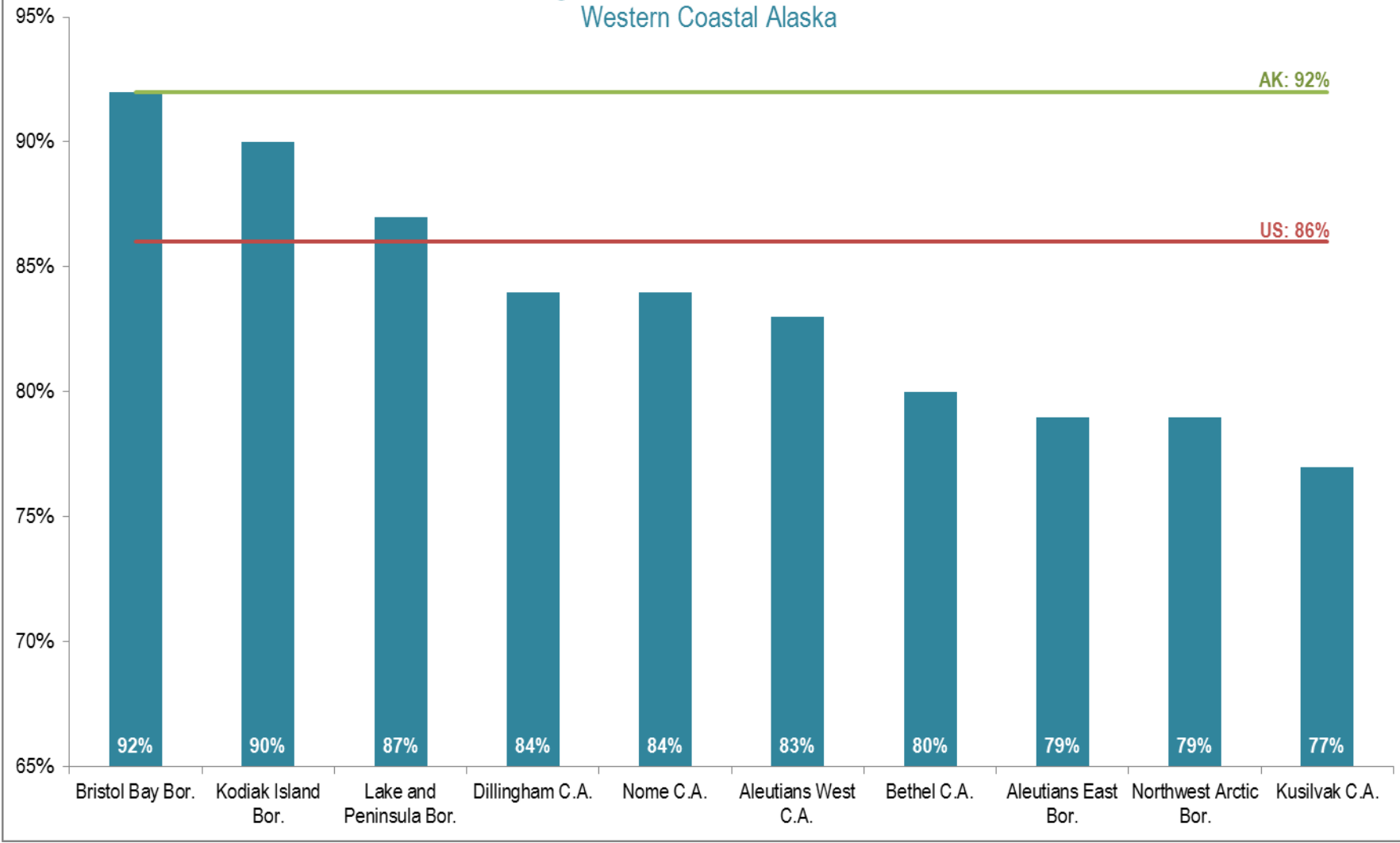

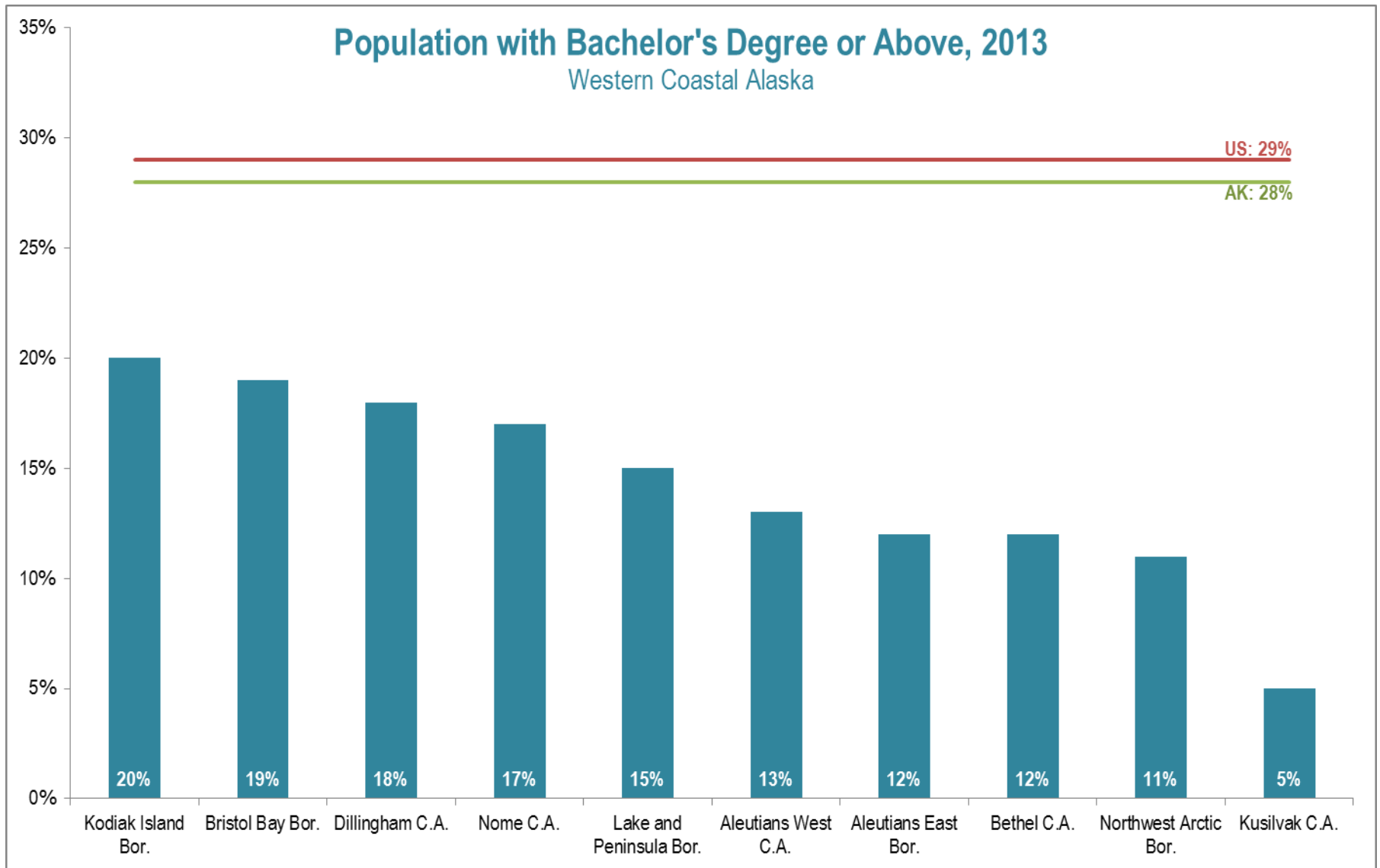

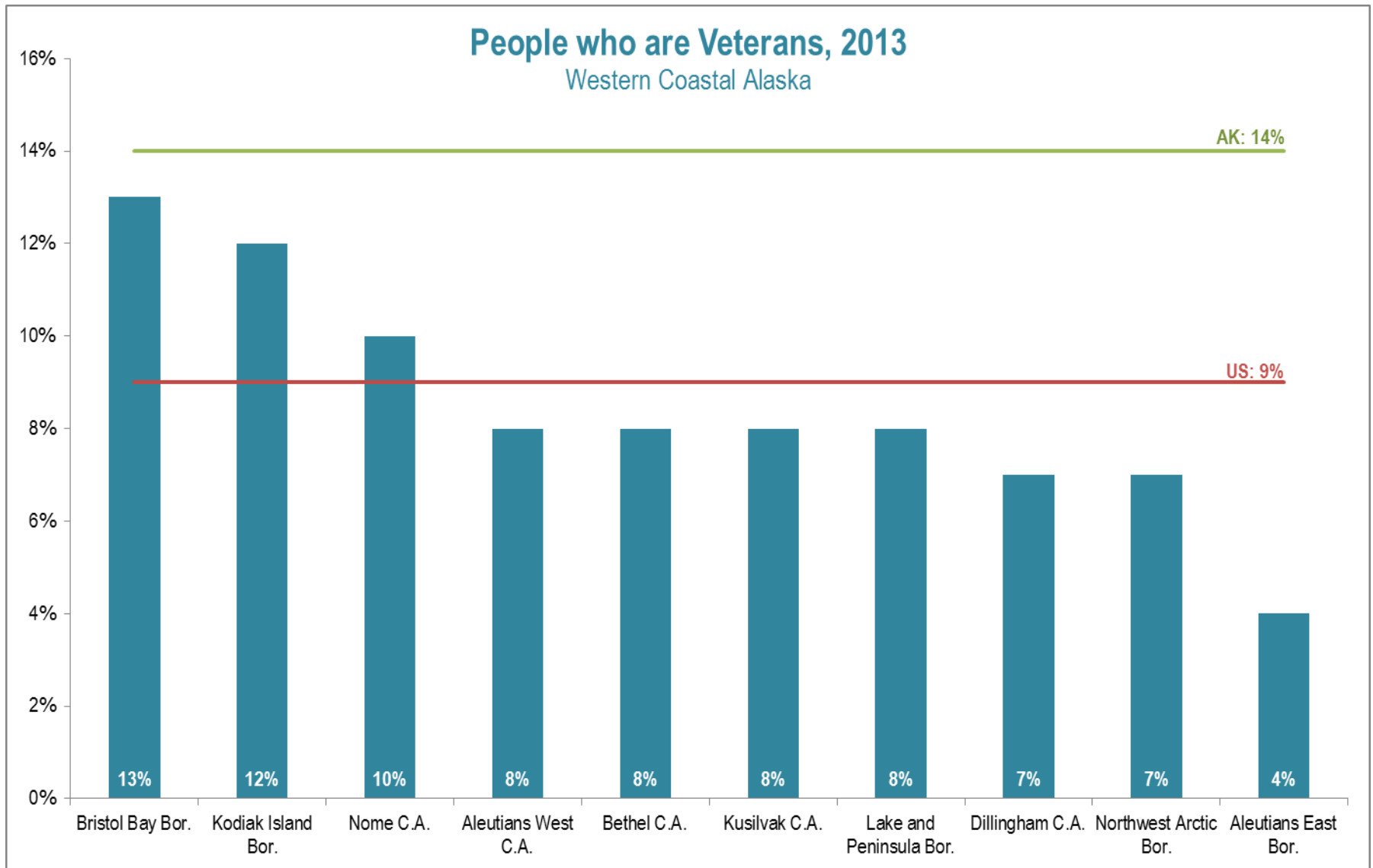

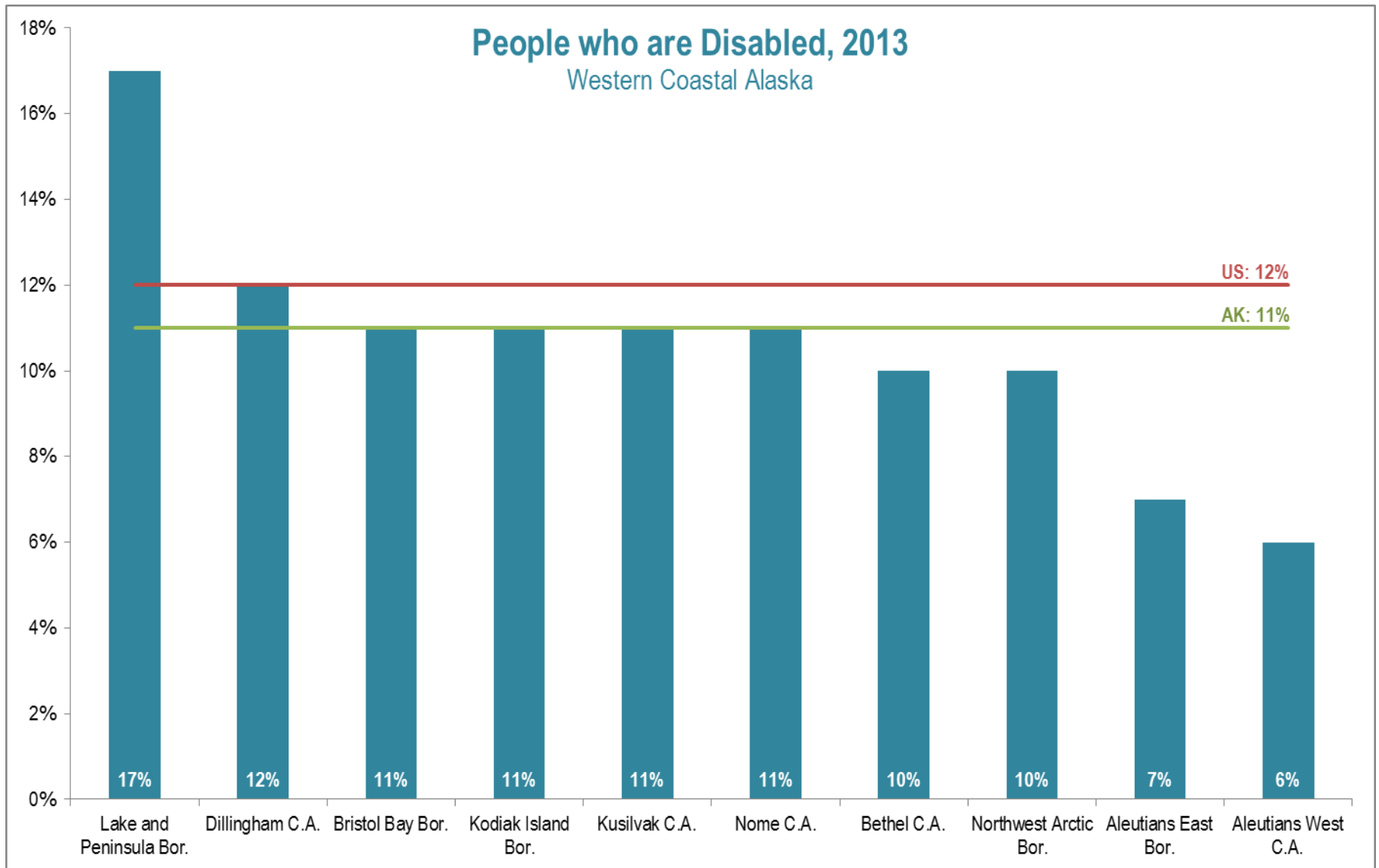

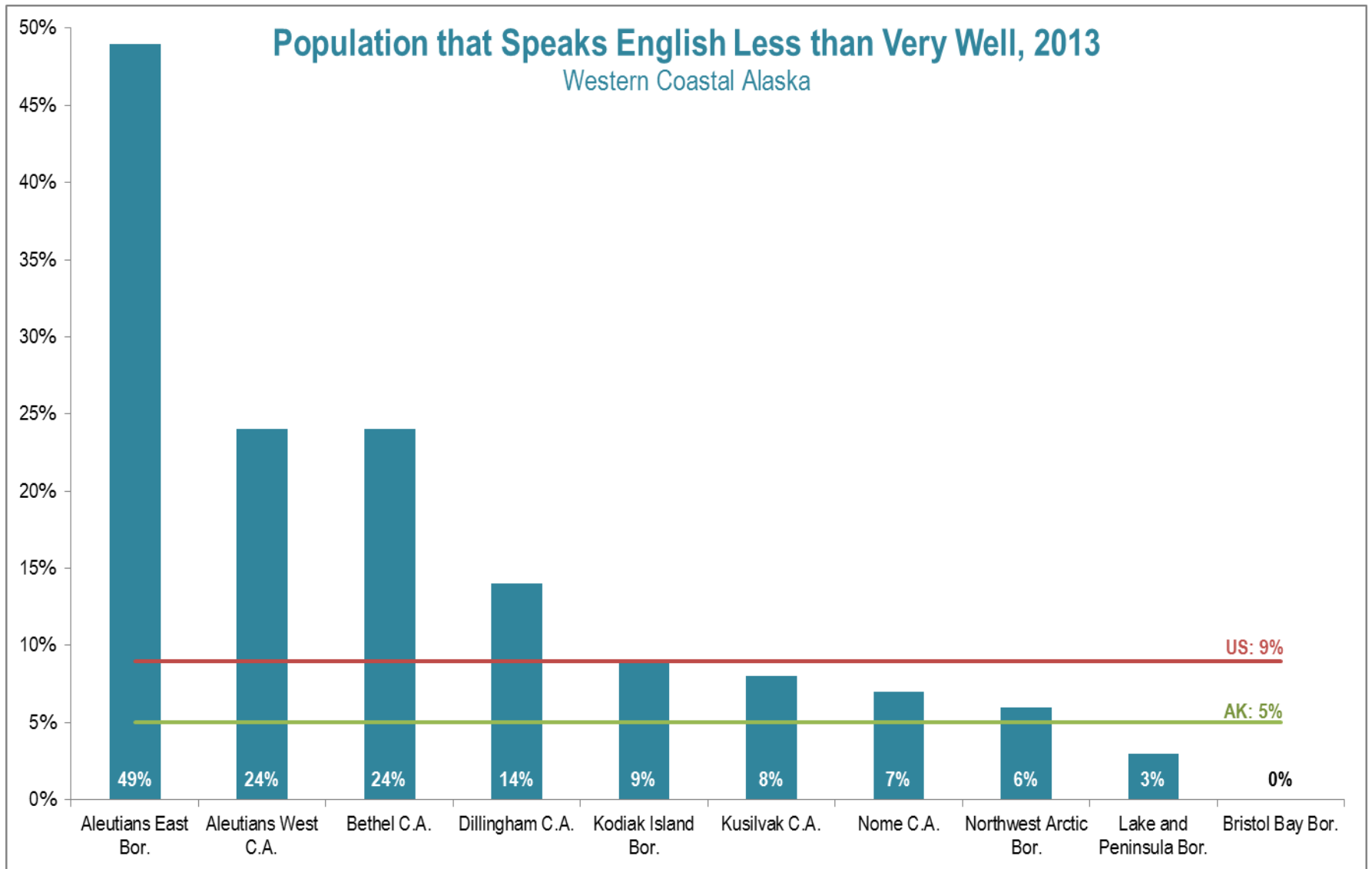

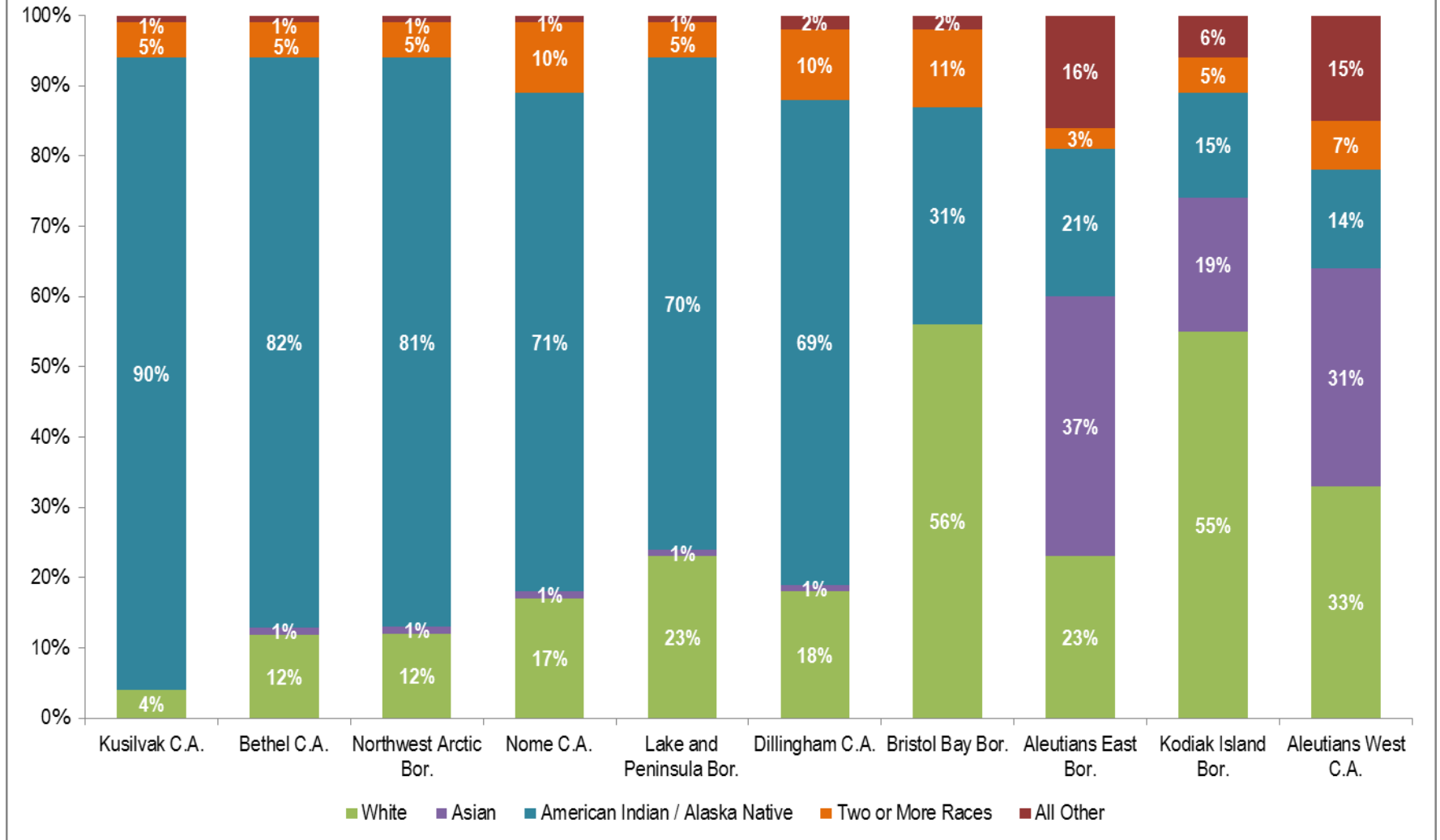

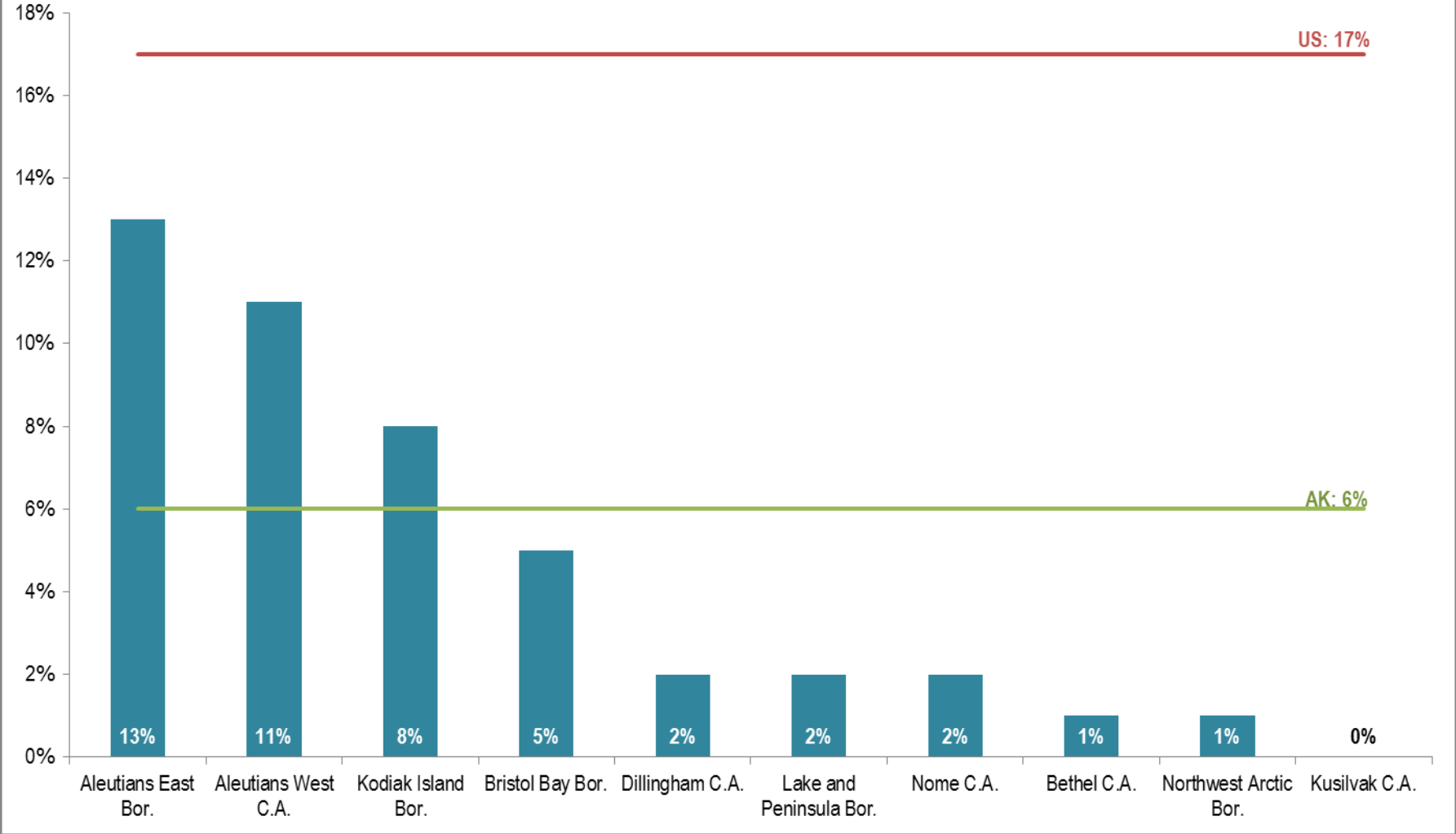
Population by Race, 2013 Western Coastal Alaska

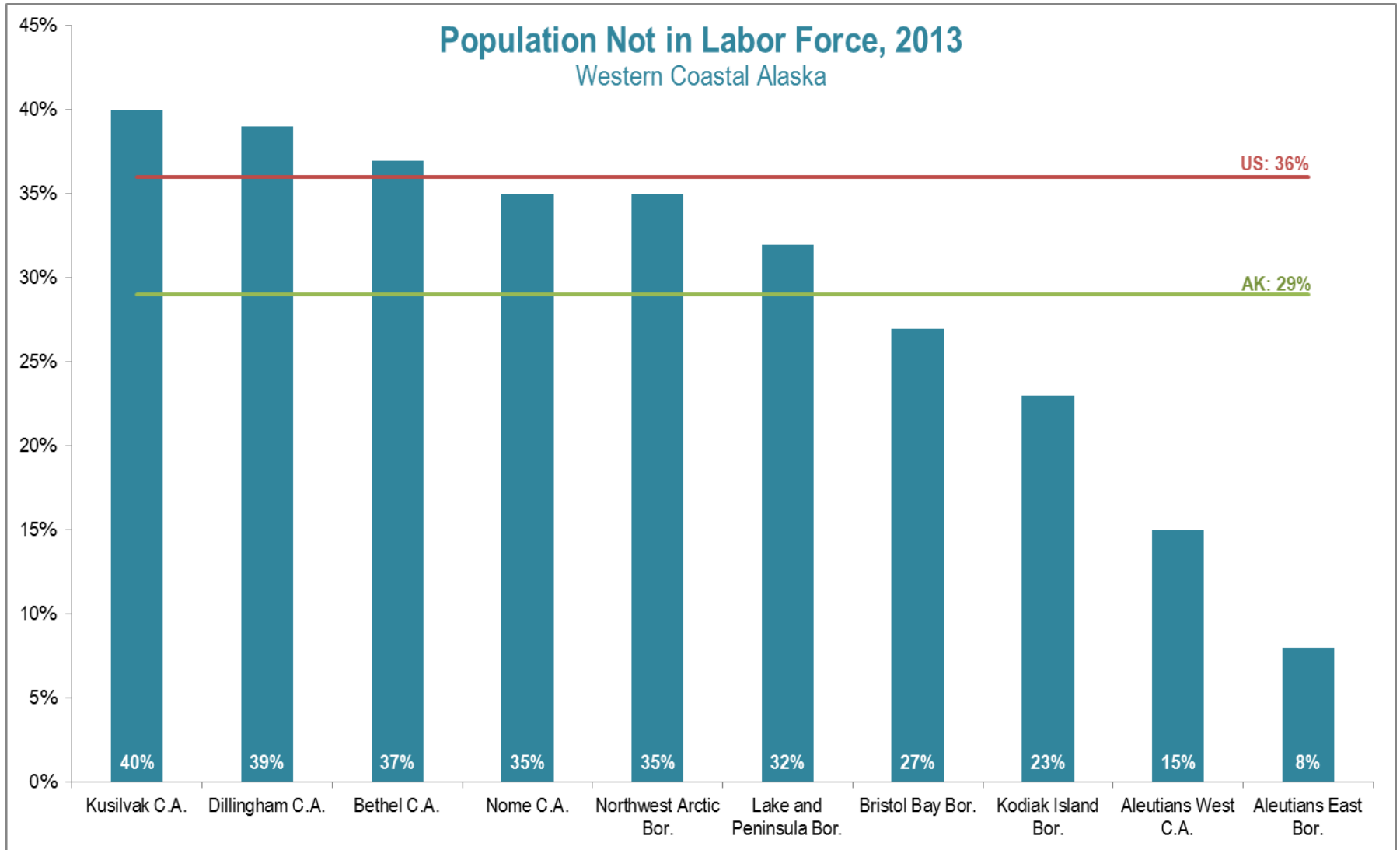
Population that is Hispanic or Latino, 2013

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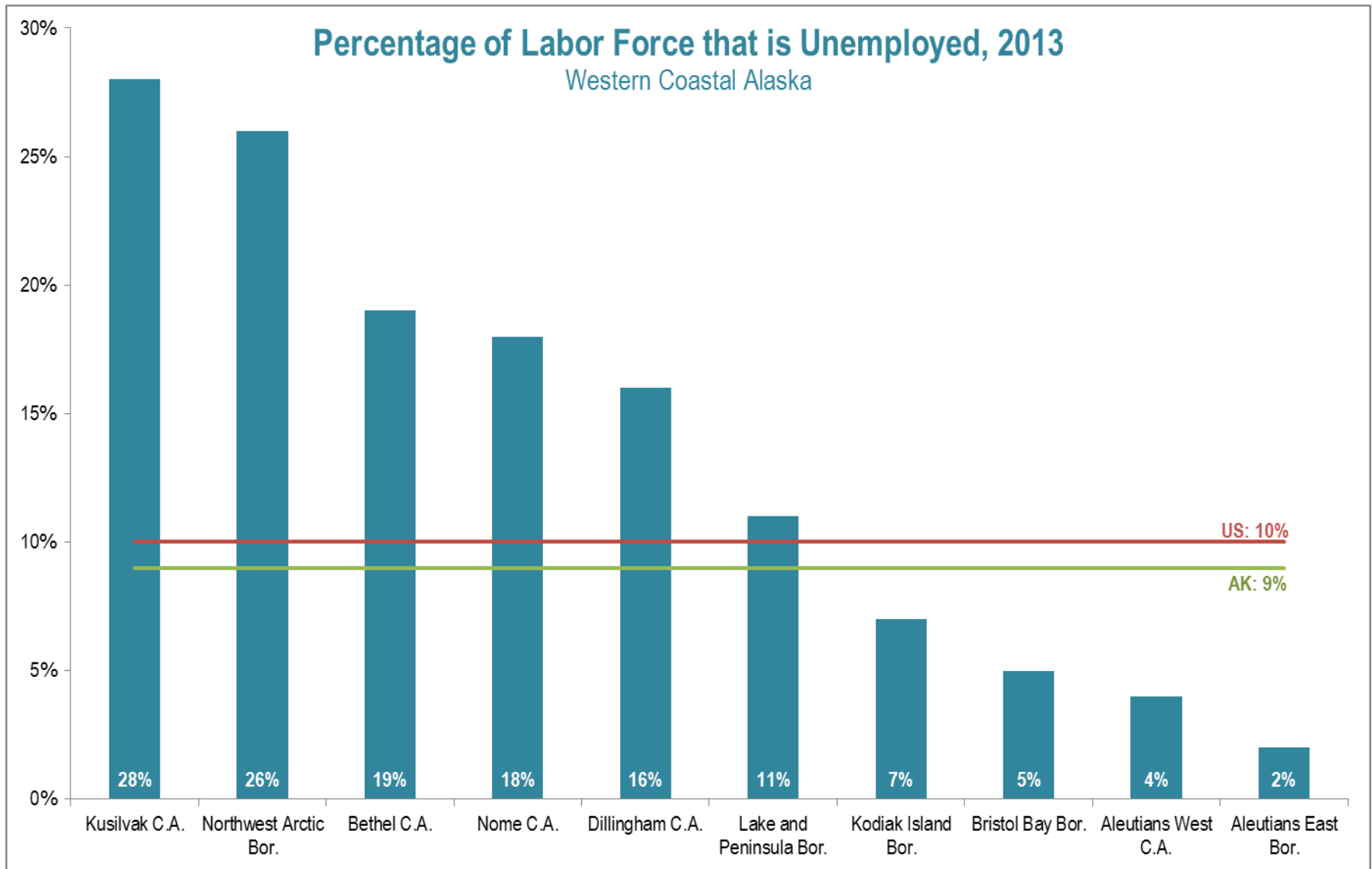

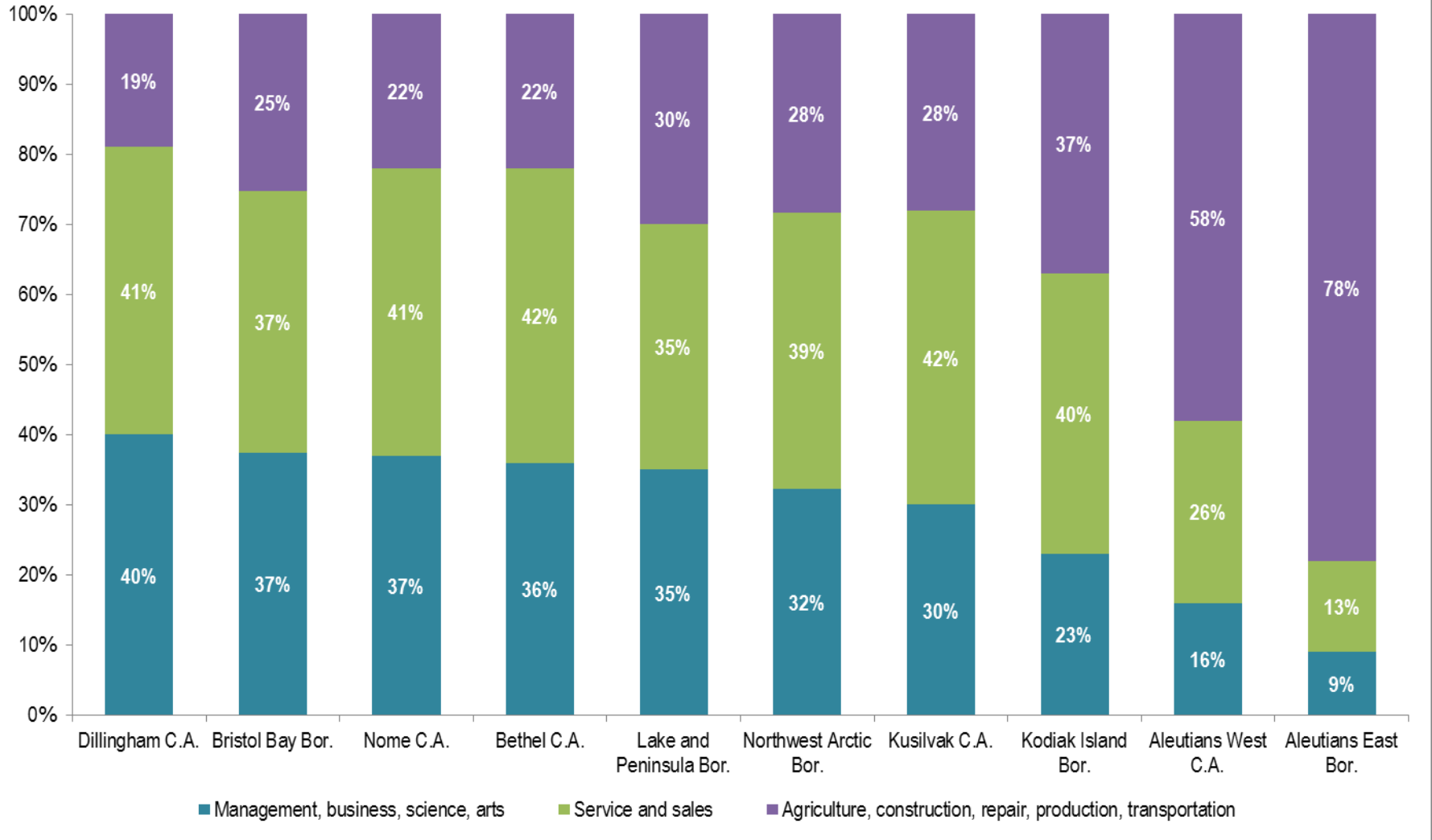

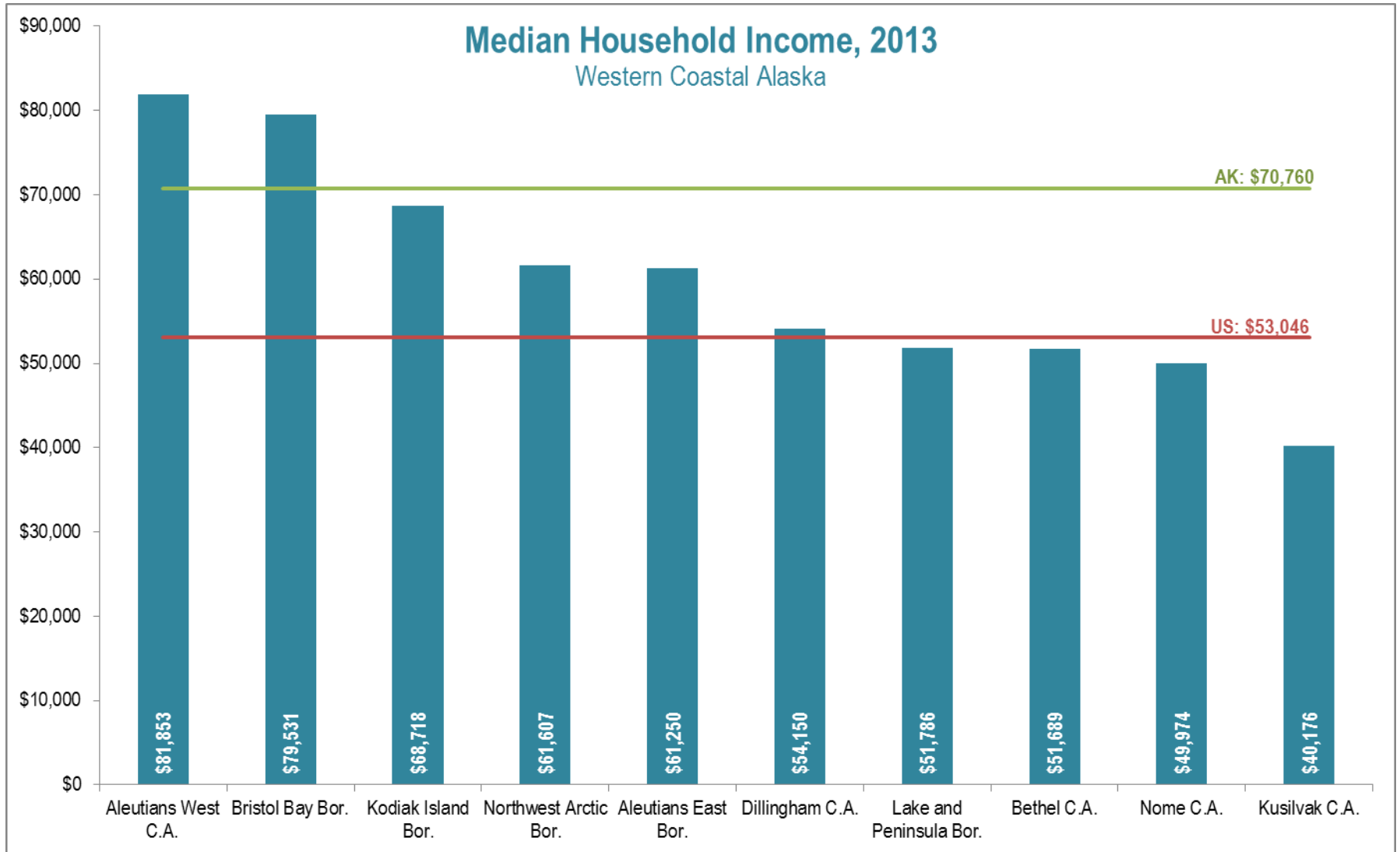

Population Over Age 16 by Occupation, 2013 Western Coastal Alaska

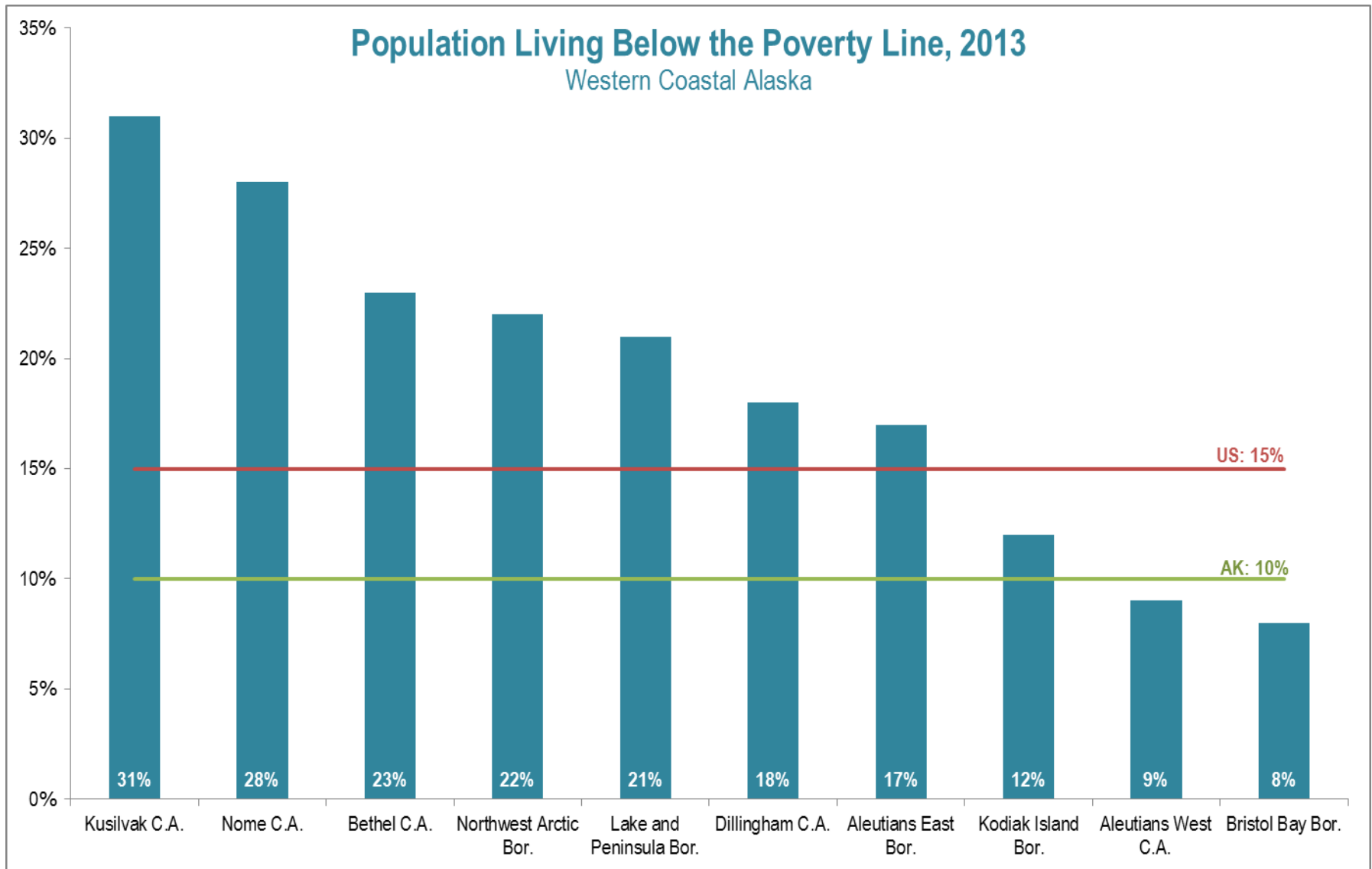

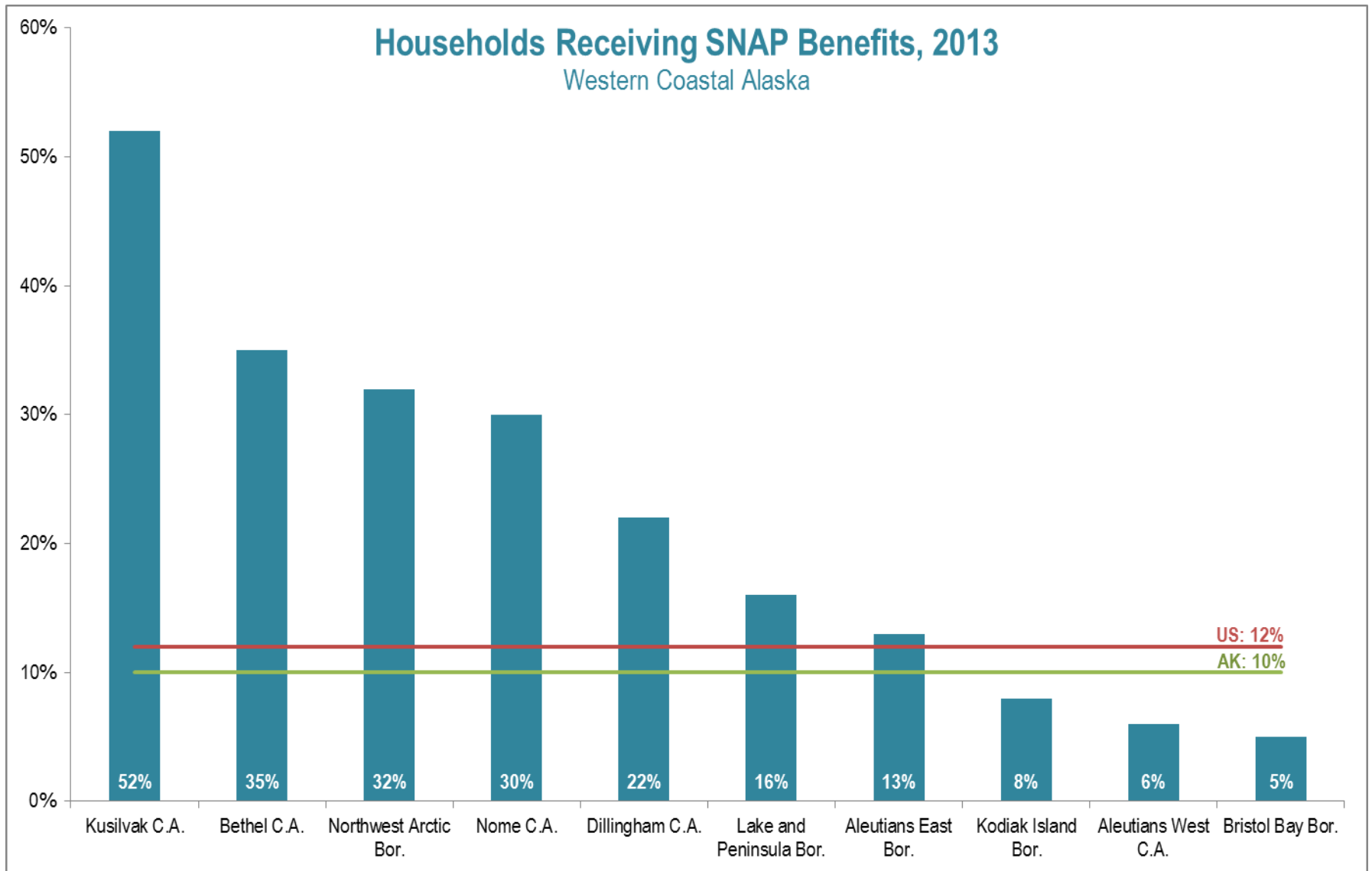

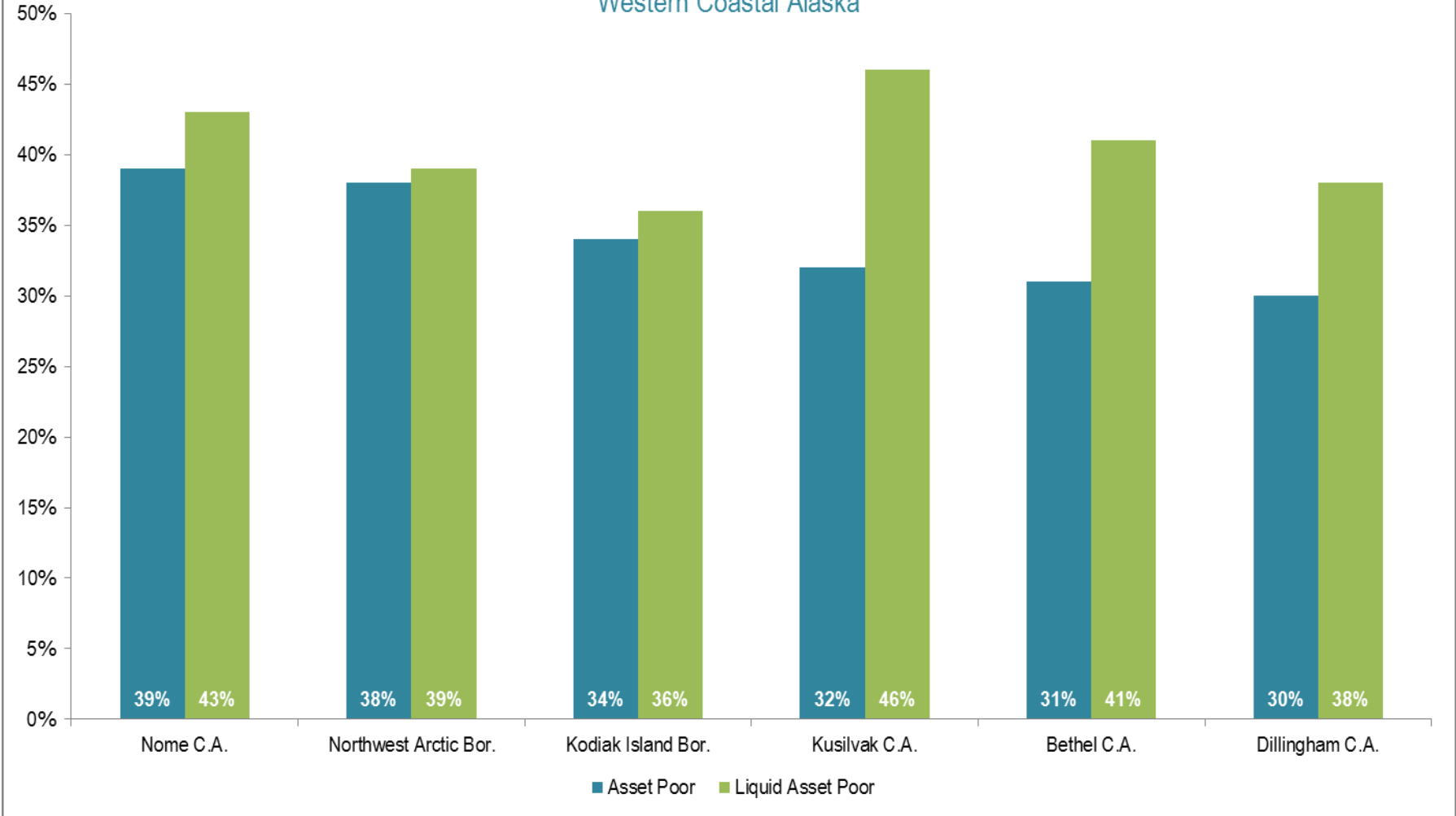

Households that are Asset Poor or Liquid Asset Poor, 2014

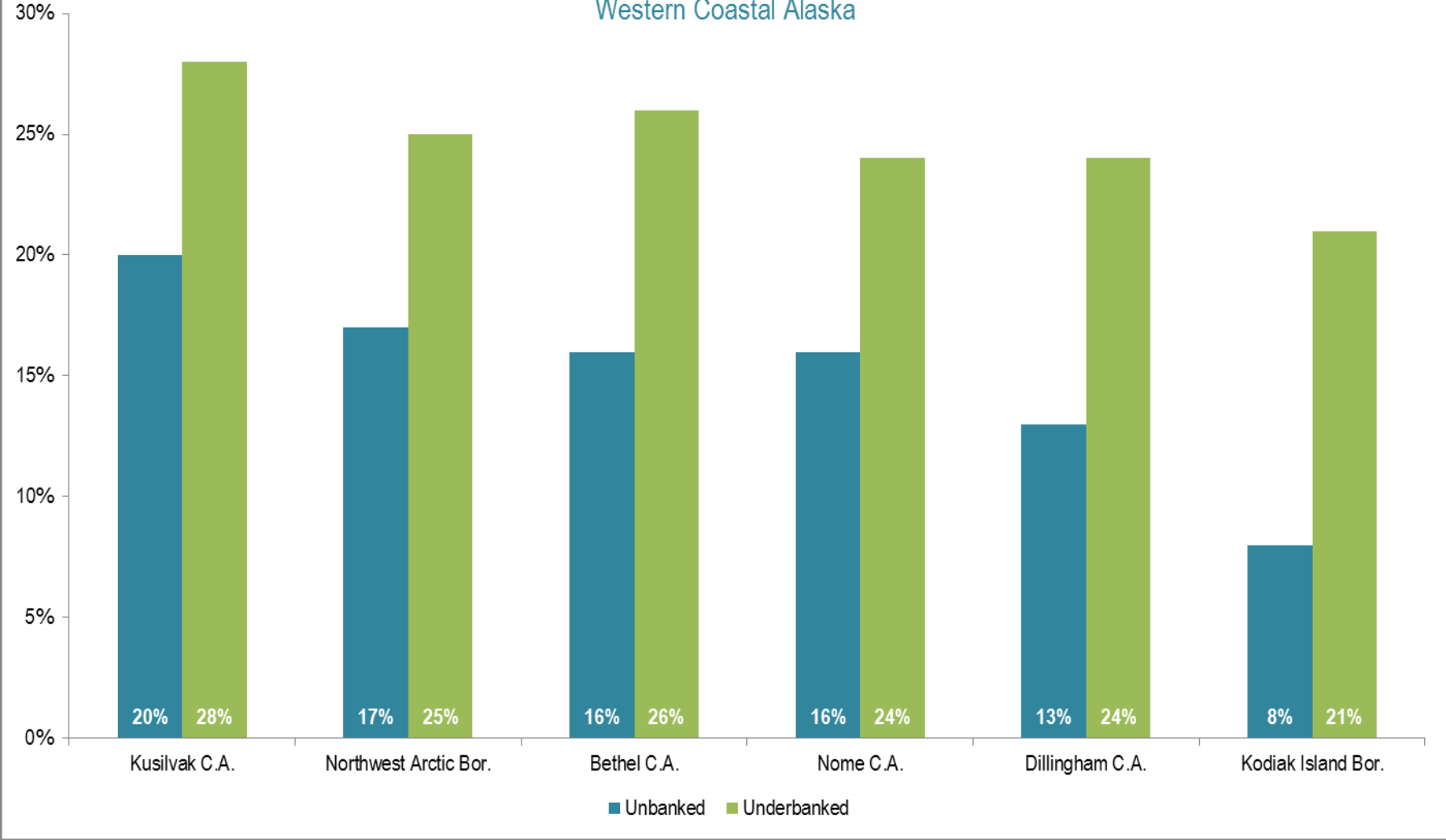

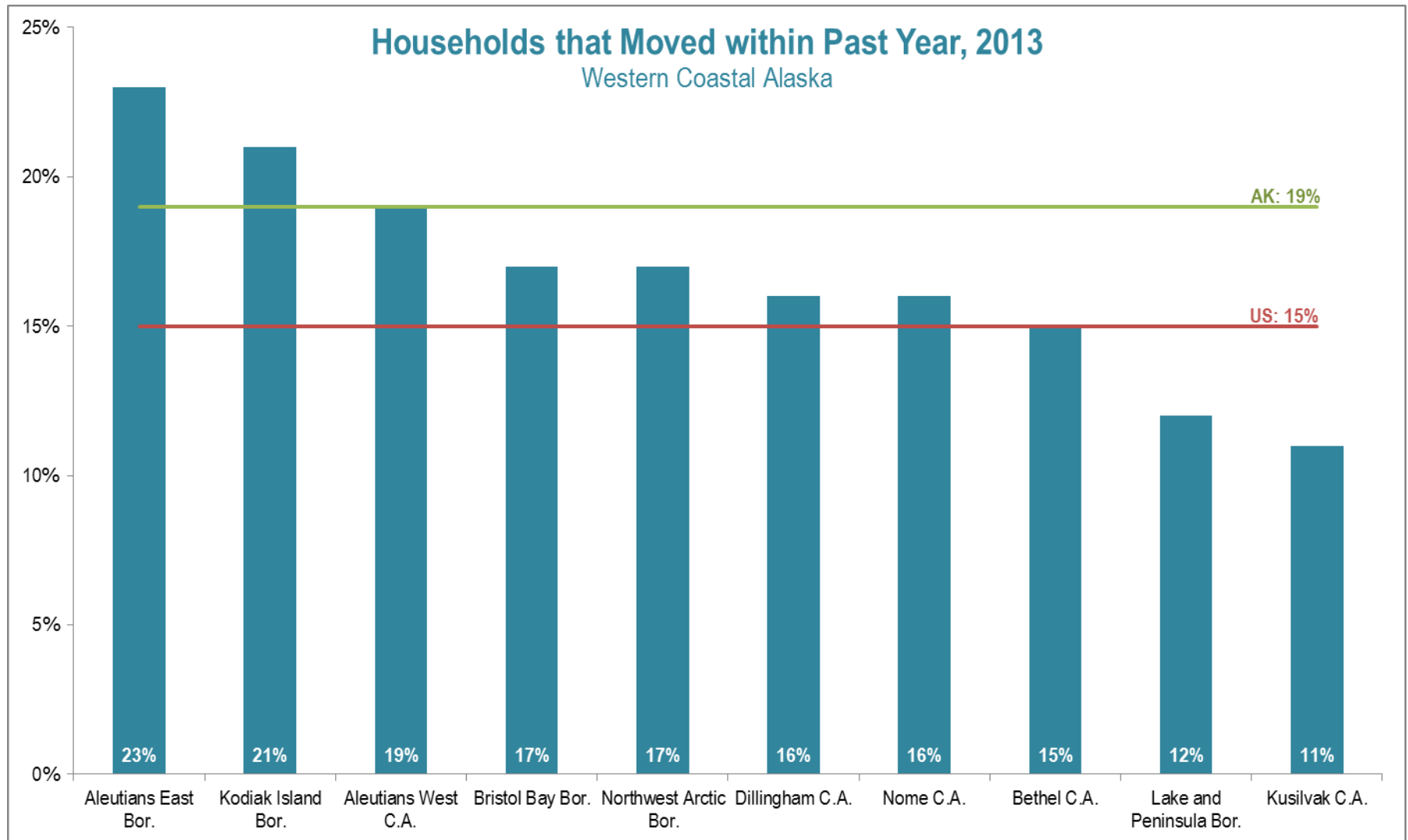
Households that are Unbanked or Underbanked, 2014

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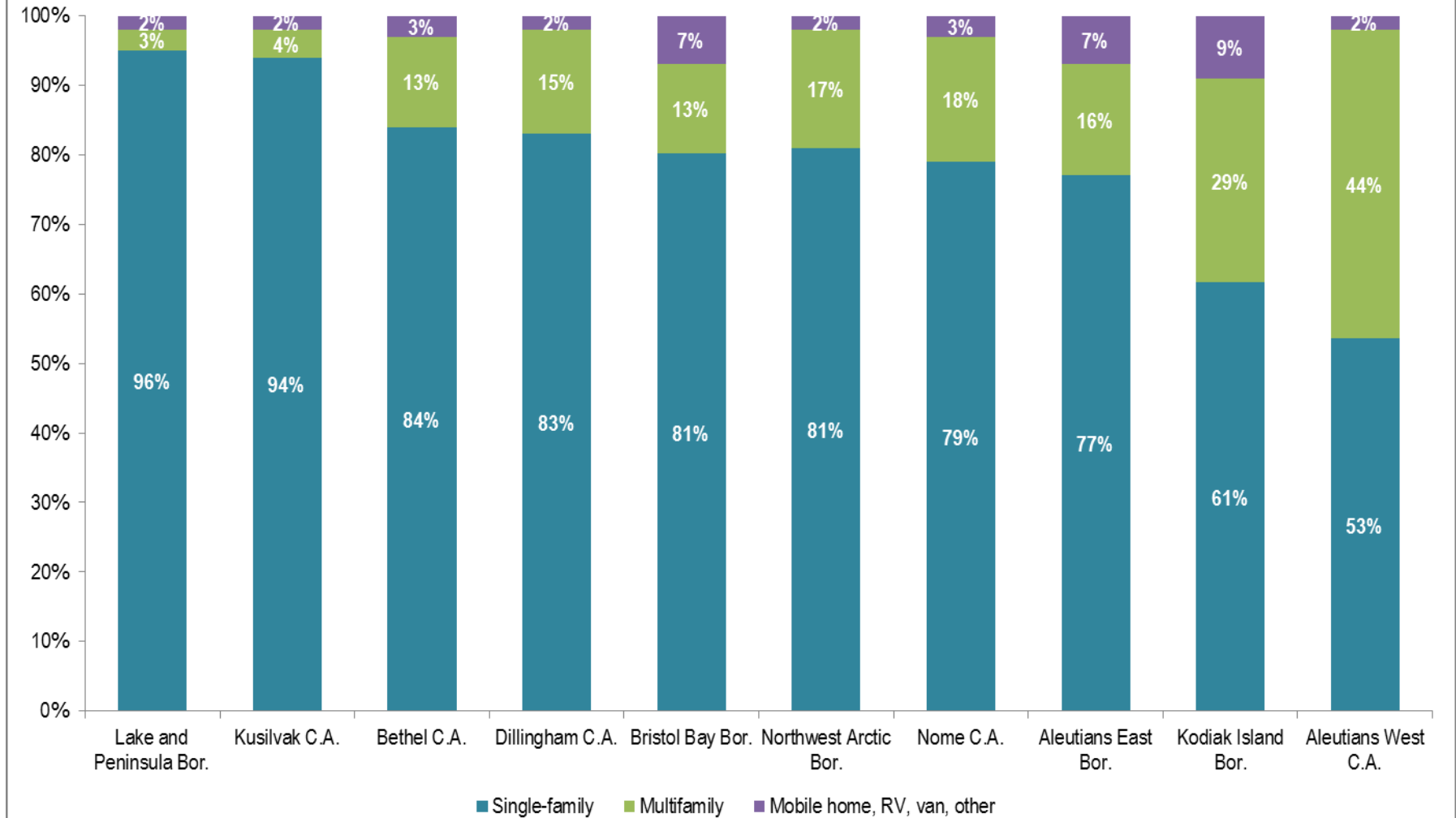

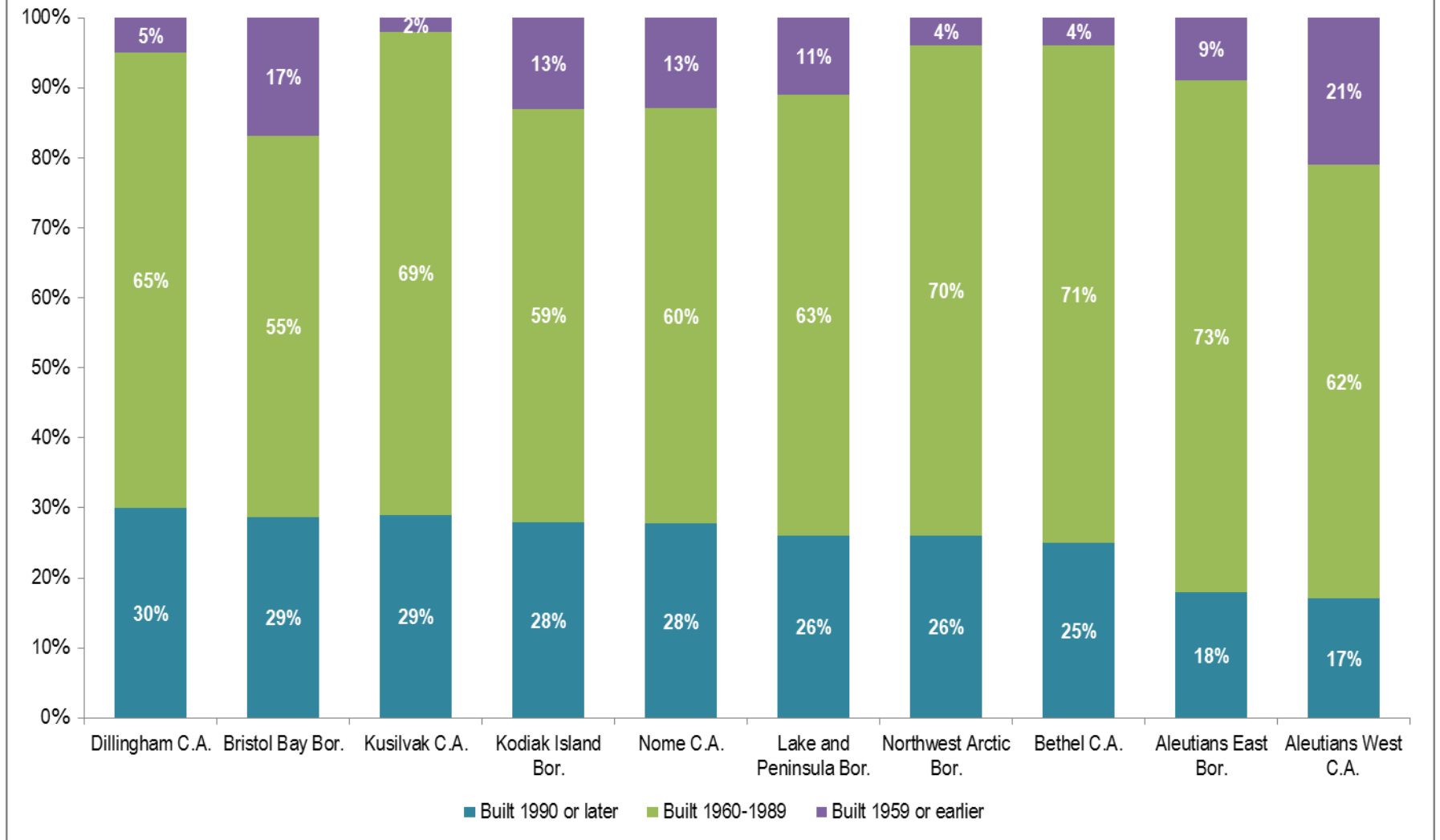

Housing Stock by Type, 2013 Western Coastal Alaska

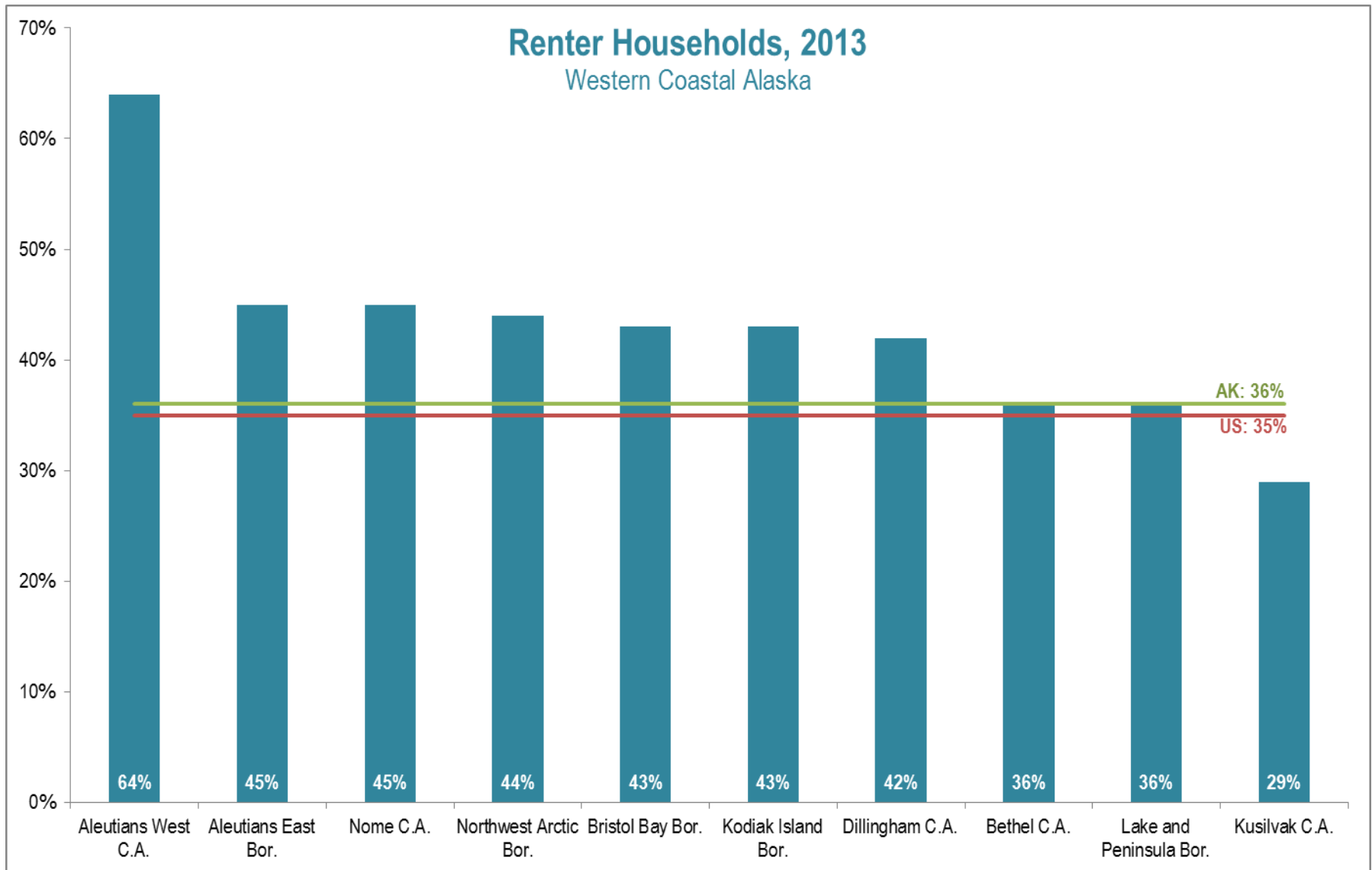

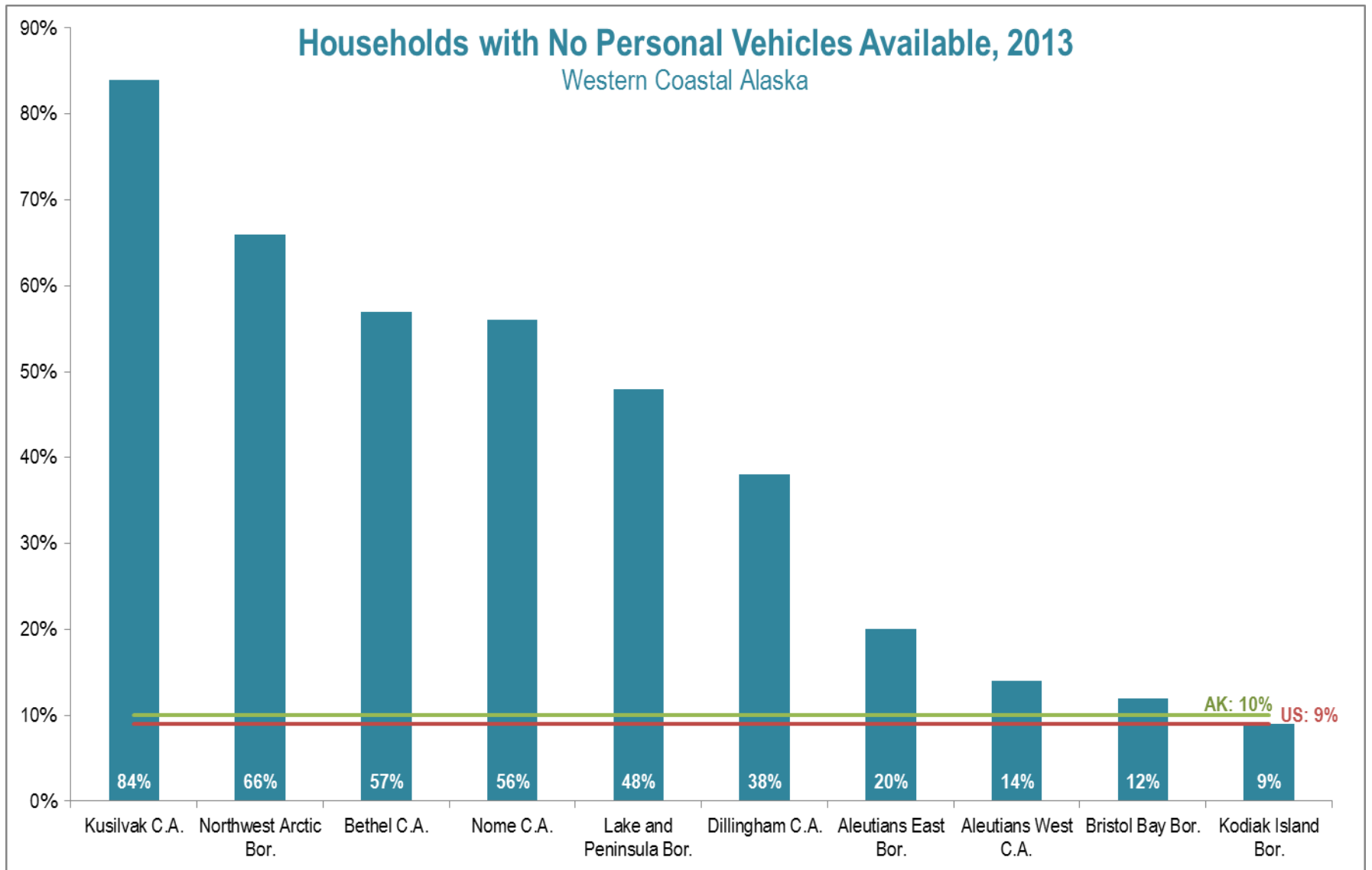
Housing Stock by Year Constructed, 2013 Western Coastal Alaska

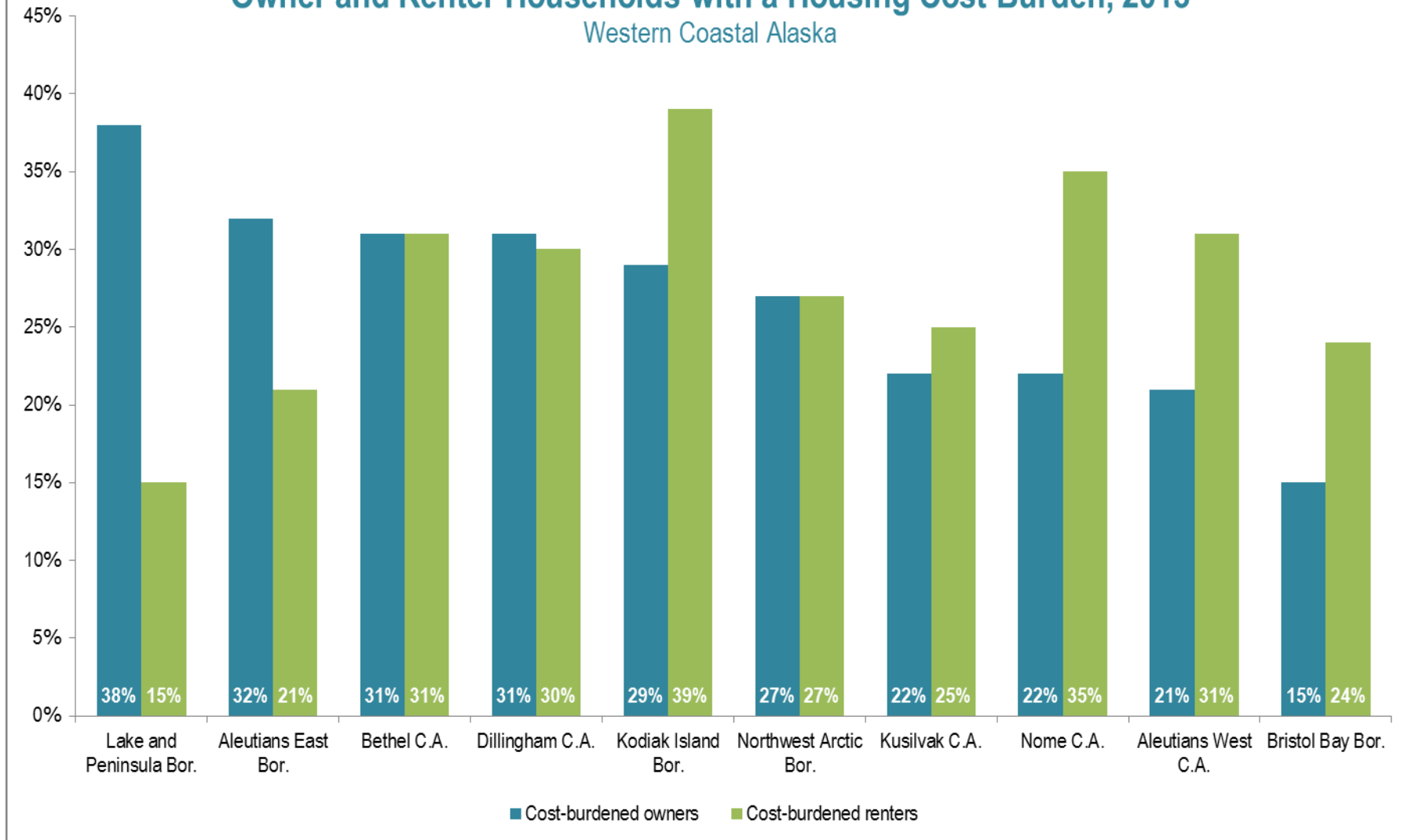
